The current general conditions relating to all English Golf Union Championships and Tournaments will apply to this Championship.

1. Conditions of Play and Qualifications.

The Broadstone Open shall be decided by Stroke Play over 36 holes at Broadstone and the winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest aggregate gross score. The Organising Committee's decision in all matters is Final. Competitors are permitted to use Distance Measuring Devices, this applies to devices that measure distance only, not any other conditions that might affect a player's game such as wind or gradient.

2. Prizes.

Vouchers to a maximum value of £1,000, shall be given for the leading ten places (provided there are 45 entrants) together with such other prizes as may be decided by the Organising Committee and shall be presented at the Club, following the day's play. 1st prize for the Broadstone Scratch Open shall be decided on a sudden death play-off, other places shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3, 1 holes, as required to make a decision.

3. Qualification.

To be eligible to enter, a player must be in possession of a playing handicap not exceeding 5 under the current standard scratch score and handicap scheme of the Council of National Golf Unions. In addition, the 'active' playing handicap must be certified by the Secretary or Handicapping Authority of the player's Home Club.

4. Entries and Fees.

Entries must be made on this form as specified by the Organising Committee of Broadstone (Dorset) Golf Club.

The entry fee for the Broadstone Open is £35.00p
Entries close at noon on Tuesday 27th August 2010.

5. Practice Rounds.

Competitors will have be permitted a practice round at a specially reduced rate of £16.00p during the week prior and will be limited to one round per person, (Telephone for booking) 01202 692595.

6. Ballot.

Where entries exceed 45 in number, there will be a ballot amongst the highest handicaps to reduce the entries to that number. However, the Organising Committee reserve the right to allow 5 Members from Broadstone, with handicaps 3 or better to be included in the final start sheet.
