2nd: Silver Medal & £200 voucher for the runner up
3rd: £150 voucher / 4th: £100 voucher / 5th: £75.00 voucher
A £75 voucher is awarded for the best score on each course.

Starting Times: Starting sheets will be posted on the website after the closing date.

Entrance Fee: **£50.00 per player** to include Coffee & Bacon rolls and one course Carvery lunch (Non refundable after the starting sheets have been sent)

Dress Standards: Smart casual golfing apparel on the courses (tailored long shorts are permissible with long stockings or white sports socks).

Practice Facilities: Competitors may practice on the day prior to the competition free of charge. At any other time a charge of £35.00 will be made. Practice period commences 1st June, excluding Saturday and Sunday.

Conditions:

1. Handicap limit is 5 at the time of entry. Entries must be received by 18th May 2012. Entry is limited to 108 competitors. If over-subscribed higher handicaps will be balloted out. The Committee of Frilford Heath has the right to refuse any entry.
2. The competition will be played under the rules of The Royal & Ancient Golf Club and the local rules of Frilford Heath Golf Club
3. The Committee of Frilford Heath Golf Club will be in charge of the competition and their decisions will be final
4. In the event of a tie for first place, winners of the Gold & Silver Medals will be decided by medal play-off over four holes selected by the Committee. In the event of there still being a tie, sudden-death arrangements will apply. Winners of the other prizes will be decided by count-back on the Blue Course and if still tied on the Green course card.
5. No competitors may take more than one prize
6. The draw for playing partners and starting times will be made by the Committee and competitors will be advised. No entrance fees will be returned after the draw has been made.
7. Caddies may be used, but must hold amateur golfing status.
